



These are the protocols that RtI Teams will follow to determine a student’s eligibility for being FASTTRACKED on the RtI model. A principal is the only one, outside of the RtI Team (which includes the classroom teacher) who can make the decision to FASTTRACK a student. Even when a student is FastTracked, the RtI paperwork must still be completed.

FASTTRACK PROTOCOLS

<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Student is harming himself or others2. Student is continually and consistently preventing himself or others from learning3. Student is not disturbing others but their lack of attention and focus is affecting their ability to learn.4. Student is continually causing serious property damage/vandalism	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Student is new to site and is assessed at 2 yrs below current grade level2. Student consistently shows a lack of progress, based on interventions provided, with at least two grade level or school wide assessments.3. Previous documented interventions have been shown to be unsuccessful based on assessment data4. Student has a sudden and dramatic drop in scores.
